## HB 1450.E - DIGEST

## (DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Reduces the overall costs of the state assessment system by implementing the eleventh grade English language arts and mathematics assessments being developed by a multistate consortium in which Washington is participating.

Maximizes use of the consortium assessments by developing a tenth grade high school English language arts assessment and modifying the algebra I and geometry end-of-course assessment to be used only during the transition to the consortiumdeveloped assessments.

Reduces the number of assessments that will be required for students to graduate beginning with the class of 2019.

Provides that the eleventh grade consortium-developed assessments have two different student performance standards as follows: (1) One for the purposes of high school graduation that will be established by the state board of education; and (2) one that is intended to demonstrate a student's career and college readiness.
