Providing immunity for health care providers following directions contained in a form developed pursuant to RCW 43.70.480.

Provides immunity from liability for health care providers who follow directions relating to futile treatment and natural death directives.

Requires the department of licensing to initiate a voluntary yellow dot program to assist owners and lessees of motor vehicles and their passengers, emergency medical responders, and law enforcement personnel in the event of a motor vehicle accident, a medical emergency, or other interaction involving emergency medical responders or law enforcement personnel.

Concerning disciplinary actions against the health professions license of the subject of a department of social and health services' finding.

Prohibits a person, who applies for or holds a license or temporary practice permit and has a final finding issued by the department of social and health services of abuse or neglect of a minor or abuse, abandonment, neglect, or financial exploitation of a vulnerable adult, from practicing a health care profession in this state until proceedings of the appropriate disciplining authority have been completed.

Transfers certain powers, duties, and functions of the legislative ethics board and the executive ethics board to the public disclosure commission.

Repeals the legislative ethics board and the executive ethics board.

Creates the public disclosure electronic filing account.

Requires the Washington state patrol to conduct random emphasis patrols to enforce the covering of loads requirements.

(2) Corrective action is needed to reduce the cost and burden of testing.

Bases student and school accountability on only those assessment requirements that are mandated under federal law.

Eliminates the high school completion pilot program.

Prohibits a person with an HIV infection from having sexual intercourse with any other person, unless such other person has been informed of the presence of the infection.

Allows beer and wine specialty stores to provide single-serving samples of two ounces or less to customers for the purpose of sales promotion without prior board qualification.

Requires the lessor or owner of a qualified building to comply with the apprenticeship utilization requirements in order to be eligible for certain tax deferrals.

Requires the lessor or owner of a warehouse or grain elevator to comply with the apprenticeship utilization requirements in order to be eligible for the warehouse and grain elevator sales tax exemption.

Requires any person establishing or operating an anaerobic digester to treat primarily livestock manure to comply with the apprenticeship utilization requirements in order to be eligible for the anaerobic digester retail sales tax exemption.

Requires a person taking the biodiesel blend or E85 sales and use tax exemptions to comply with the apprenticeship utilization requirements.

Requires specified entities to comply with the prevailing wages on public works requirements to receive certain tax deferrals and exemptions.

Prohibits the department from mailing the license to an address outside the state.
