Dear Mr. Dean,

On May 21, 2013, following passage by the House and Senate, Washington Governor Jay Inslee signed House Bill (HB) 1183 -- an Act relating to wireless communications structures amending RCW 43.21C.0384 and creating a new section. The bill became effective on July 28, 2013. HB 1183 created reporting requirements; specifically, Section 1 (4) provides:

***By January 1, 2020, all wireless service providers granted an exemption to RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c) must provide the legislature with the number of permits issued pertaining to wireless service facilities, the number of exemptions granted under this section, and the total dollar investment in wireless service facilities between July 1, 2013, and June 30, 2019.***

Since the effective date, AT&T has been tracking and compiling the required information to provide a report to the Washington Legislature in compliance with the requirements in HB 1183. The required information for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2019 is below:

Number of Permits Issued Pertaining to Wireless Facilities: 3,647  
Number of Exemptions Granted to RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c): 3,587  
Total Dollar Investment in Wireless Facilities: \$3.065 billion<sup>1</sup>
