Dear Senator Cleveland and Representative Cody:

This report fulfills the requirements of <u>RCW 18.225.800</u>, which directs the Department of Health (department) to annually report, through 2020, the number of times mental health providers¹ with an associate's license renew their credential four, five, and six times. We submitted our first report in October 2014.

Major Findings

In state fiscal year 2019, 89.6 percent of those who obtained their mental health provider licensure did so with four or fewer renewals of their associate license. Another 5.1 percent did so with five renewals and 4.9 percent with six renewals².

Background

The department began issuing associate licenses for mental health professions in July 2009. At the time, an associate license could be renewed annually no more than four times. This meant associates had five years (initial associate licensure plus four annual renewals) to complete the additional education and supervisory requirements to apply for licensure as a mental health counselor, marriage and family therapist, advanced social worker, or independent clinical social worker.

In 2013, the <u>House Bill 1213</u> expanded the number of renewals allowed for an associate license from four to six. At the same time, the department was directed to submit this annual report to help the legislature assess whether these expanded limits on associate licensure renewals remain adequate.

¹ Mental Health providers include: Mental Health Counselors, Marriage and Family Therapists, Advanced Social Workers, and Independent Clinical Social Workers.

² During the production of this report, the department discovered a system error which allowed two licensees to renew more than the limit allows before obtaining full licensure. The department is undergoing a thorough investigation into the cause of this error. This error accounts for the remaining 0.4 percent.

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Data

Table 1 shows the number of times associate licenses were renewed among those who are fully licensed by profession and fiscal year. Table 2 shows the number of associate license renewals by profession and fiscal year.

⁴ The system error identified by the department also resulted in 8 associates receiving a seventh renewal in fiscal year 2018 and 21 associates receiving a seventh or eighth renewal in fiscal year 2019. The department is currently investigating and will report on the results of this investigation in a follow-up letter.
