1 AN ACT Relating to studying traffic safety education options for
2 students receiving home-based instruction; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) The office of the superintendent of
5 public instruction, jointly with the department of licensing, shall
6 convene an advisory committee of experts and stakeholders to study ways
7 to make traffic safety education more accessible to students who
8 receive home-based instruction. The membership of the advisory
9 committee shall include the superintendent of public instruction or the
10 superintendent's designee, commercial driving schools, the Washington
11 homeschool organization, private providers, and parents.

12 (2) The study, along with its recommendations, shall be completed
13 by January 1, 2008, and the results reported to the governor and the
14 legislature.
