- AN ACT Relating to allowing a six percent property tax limit for emergency medical care and service levies; amending RCW 84.55.0101; and

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 84.55.0101 and 2007 sp. s. c 1 s 2 (House Bill No. 6 2416) are each amended to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Upon a finding of substantial need, the legislative authority
- 8 of a taxing district other than the state may provide for the use of a 9 limit factor under this chapter of one hundred one percent or less.

- 10 <u>unless provided otherwise in subsection (2) of this section</u>. In
- 11 districts with legislative authorities of four members or less, two-

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The secretary of state shall submit this act to the people for their adoption and ratification, or rejection, at the next general election to be held in this state, in accordance with Article II, section 1 of the state Constitution and the laws adopted to

7 facilitate its operation.

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
