17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

18 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 26.60 RCW
19 to read as follows:

20 It is the intent of the legislature that for all purposes under
21 state law, state registered domestic partners shall be treated the same
22 as married spouses. Any privilege, immunity, right, benefit, or
23 responsibility granted or imposed by statute, administrative or court
24 rule, policy, common law or any other law to an individual because the
25 individual is or was a spouse, or because the individual is or was an
26 in-law in a specified way to another individual, is granted on
27 equivalent terms, substantive and procedural, to an individual because
28 the individual is or was in a state registered domestic partnership or
29 because the individual is or was, based on a state registered domestic
30 partnership, related in a specified way to another individual. The
31 provisions of this act shall be liberally construed to achieve equal
32 treatment, to the extent not in conflict with federal law, of state
33 registered domestic partners and married spouses.

34 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 34.05 RCW
35 to read as follows:

1 Agencies shall amend their rules to reflect the intent of the
2 legislature to ensure that all privileges, immunities, rights,
3 benefits, or responsibilities granted or imposed by statute to an
4 individual because that individual is or was a spouse in a marital
5 relationship are granted or imposed on equivalent terms to an
6 individual because that individual is or was in a state registered
7 domestic partnership.

8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 2.10 RCW

24 (1) "Retirement system" means the "Washington judicial retirement
25 system" provided herein.

26 (2) "Judge" means a person elected or appointed to serve as judge
27 of a court of record as provided in chapters 2.04, 2.06, and 2.08 RCW.
28 "Judge" does not include a person serving as a judge pro tempore except
29 for a judge pro tempore appointed under RCW 2.04.240(2) or 2.06.150(2).

30 (3) "Retirement board" means the "Washington judicial retirement
31 board" established herein.

32 (4) "Surviving spouse" means the surviving widow or widower or
33 surviving state registered domestic partner of a judge. "Surviving
34 spouse" does not include the divorced spouse of a judge or an
35 individual whose state registered domestic partnership with the judge
36 has been terminated, dissolved, or invalidated.

1 (5) "Retirement fund" means the "Washington judicial retirement
2 fund" established herein.

3 (6) "Beneficiary" means any person in receipt of a retirement
4 allowance, disability allowance or any other benefit described herein.

5 (7) "Monthly salary" means the monthly salary of the position held
6 by the judge.

7 (8) "Service" means all periods of time served as a judge, as
8 herein defined. Any calendar month at the beginning or end of a term
9 in which ten or more days are served shall be counted as a full month
10 of service: PROVIDED, That no more than one month's service may be
11 granted for any one calendar month. Only months of service will be
12 counted in the computation of any retirement allowance or other benefit
13 provided for in this chapter. Years of service shall be determined by
14 dividing the total months of service by twelve. Any fraction of a year
15 of service as so determined shall be taken into account in the
16 computation of such retirement allowance or benefit.

17 (9) "Final average salary" means (a) for a judge in service in the
18 same court for a minimum of twelve consecutive months preceding the
19 date of retirement, the salary attached to the position held by the
20 judge immediately prior to retirement; (b) for any other judge, the
21 average monthly salary paid over the highest twenty-four month period
22 in the last ten years of service.

23 (10) "Retirement allowance" for the purpose of applying cost of
24 living increases or decreases includes retirement allowances,
25 disability allowances and survivorship benefit.

26 (11) "Index" means for any calendar year, that year's annual
27 average consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical
28 workers, all items (1957-1959 equal one hundred) -- compiled by the
29 bureau of labor statistics, United States department of labor.

30 (12) "Accumulated contributions" means the total amount deducted
31 from the judge's monthly salary pursuant to RCW 2.10.090, together with
32 the regular interest thereon from July 1, 1988, as determined by the
33 director of the department of retirement systems.

34 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 2.12 RCW

6 (1) The notice required by RCW 6.27.130(1) to be mailed to or
7 served on an individual judgment debtor shall be in the following form,
8 printed or typed in type no smaller than elite type:

9 NOTICE OF GARNISHMENT
10 AND OF YOUR RIGHTS

11 A Writ of Garnishment issued in a Washington court has been or
12 will be served on the garnishee named in the attached copy of
13 the writ. After receipt of the writ, the garnishee is required
14 to withhold payment of any money that was due to you and to
15 withhold any other property of yours that the garnishee held or
16 controlled. This notice of your rights is required by law.

17 YOU HAVE THE FOLLOWING EXEMPTION RIGHTS:

18 WAGES. If the garnishee is your employer who owes wages or
19 other personal earnings to you, your employer is required to
20 pay amounts to you that are exempt under state and federal
21 laws, as explained in the writ of garnishment. You should
22 receive a copy of your employer's answer, which will show how
23 the exempt amount was calculated. If the garnishment is for
24 child support, the exempt amount paid to you will be forty
25 percent of wages due you, but if you are supporting a spouse,
26 state registered domestic partner, or dependent child, you are
27 entitled to claim an additional ten percent as exempt.

28 BANK ACCOUNTS. If the garnishee is a bank or other institution
29 with which you have an account in which you have deposited
30 benefits such as Temporary Assistance for Needy Families,
31 Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Social Security, veterans'
32 benefits, unemployment compensation, or a United States
33 pension, you may claim the account as fully exempt if you have
34 deposited only such benefit funds in the account. It may be
35 partially exempt even though you have deposited money from

1 other sources in the same account. An exemption is also
2 available under RCW 26.16.200, providing that funds in a
3 community bank account that can be identified as the earnings
4 of a stepparent are exempt from a garnishment on the child
5 support obligation of the parent.

6 OTHER EXEMPTIONS. If the garnishee holds other property of
7 yours, some or all of it may be exempt under RCW 6.15.010, a
8 Washington statute that exempts up to five hundred dollars of
9 property of your choice (including up to one hundred dollars in
10 cash or in a bank account) and certain property such as
11 household furnishings, tools of trade, and a motor vehicle (all
12 limited by differing dollar values).

13 HOW TO CLAIM EXEMPTIONS. Fill out the enclosed claim form and
14 mail or deliver it as described in instructions on the claim
15 form. If the plaintiff does not object to your claim, the
16 funds or other property that you have claimed as exempt must be
17 released not later than 10 days after the plaintiff receives
18 your claim form. If the plaintiff objects, the law requires a
19 hearing not later than 14 days after the plaintiff receives
20 your claim form, and notice of the objection and hearing date
21 will be mailed to you at the address that you put on the claim
22 form.

23 THE LAW ALSO PROVIDES OTHER EXEMPTION RIGHTS. IF NECESSARY, AN
24 ATTORNEY CAN ASSIST YOU TO ASSERT THESE AND OTHER RIGHTS, BUT
25 YOU MUST ACT IMMEDIATELY TO AVOID LOSS OF RIGHTS BY DELAY.

26 (2) The claim form required by RCW 6.27.130(1) to be mailed to or
27 served on an individual judgment debtor shall be in the following form,
28 printed or typed in type no smaller than elite type:

29 other law shall be construed to be gender neutral, and applicable to
30 individuals in state registered domestic partnerships.
