- (6) A school district may not include provisions in a collective bargaining agreement that limit the district's authority to grant waivers under this section.
- (7) Each school district board of directors granting waivers of state laws and rules shall submit to the superintendent of public instruction and the state board of education a list of laws and rules waived by the school district board of directors in accordance with this section.
