- 1 AN ACT Relating to the collection of survey data pursuant to 2 nurse licensure; and amending RCW 18.79.160.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.79.160 and 2004 c 262 s 6 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1) An applicant for a license to practice as a registered nurse shall submit to the commission:
 - (a) An attested written application on a department form;
- 9 (b) An official transcript demonstrating graduation and 10 successful completion of an approved program of nursing; and
 - (c) Any other official records specified by the commission.
- 12 (2) An applicant for a license to practice as an advanced 13 registered nurse practitioner shall submit to the commission:
 - (a) An attested written application on a department form;
 - (b) An official transcript demonstrating graduation and successful completion of an advanced registered nurse practitioner program meeting criteria established by the commission; and
 - (c) Any other official records specified by the commission.
- 19 (3) An applicant for a license to practice as a licensed 20 practical nurse shall submit to the commission:
- 21 (a) An attested written application on a department form;

1 (b) Written official evidence that the applicant is over the age 2 of eighteen;

- (c) An official transcript demonstrating graduation and successful completion of an approved practical nursing program, or its equivalent; and
 - (d) Any other official records specified by the commission.
- (4) At the time of submission of the application, the applicant for a license to practice as a registered nurse, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or licensed practical nurse must not be in violation of chapter 18.130 RCW or this chapter.
- 11 (5) The commission shall establish by rule the criteria for 12 evaluating the education of all applicants.
- 13 (6) The commission shall not condition licensure or license 14 renewal on the submission of demographic or other survey data not 15 directly connected to the practice of nursing.
