## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 8406

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the State of Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That immediately before adjournment SINE DIE of this 2022 Regular Session of the Sixtyseventh Legislature:

5 (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all 6 House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent resolutions, 7 and House joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed 8 by the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of 9 such measures they shall be assigned to the House Rules Committee for 10 third reading; and

(2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all 11 12 Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent Senate bills, 13 resolutions, and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have 14 not been passed by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by 15 the Senate of such measures they shall be assigned to the Senate 16 Rules Committee for third reading; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall retain in their possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE of the 2022 Regular Session of the Sixty-seventh Legislature, all legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be

1 in their respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and 2 other documents pertaining thereto; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any 4 special session of the Sixty-seventh Legislature shall be numbered as 5 a continuation of the numbers assigned to measures of the 2022 6 Regular Session of the Sixty-seventh Legislature.
