Effective Date: July 1, 2017.

Description: The health care authority (the agency) intends to submit medicaid SPA 17-0024 in order to reflect new department of health (DOH) credential requirements for applied behavior analysis (ABA) providers. The current DOH credentialing as an agency-affiliated counselor will no longer be acceptable to be recognized as a qualified apple health ABA provider.

The new DOH rules in chapter 246-805 WAC created a program for certified and licensed ABA professionals, including licensing, certification and practice standards. The new credentials are licensed behavior analyst, licensed assistant behavior analyst, and certified behavior technician (CBT).

Licensed psychologists, mental health counselors, social workers, and marriage and family therapists are able to provide ABA services without an additional credential if they have the appropriate education and training to provide ABA services and have submitted an ABA attestation to the agency's provider enrollment unit.

The adoption of the new credentials eliminates the need for ABA providers to be a licensed mental health agency with the department of behavioral health and recovery, or a home health agency or outpatient hospital with DOH, to be a qualified provider under the agency's ABA program. SPA 17-0024 is expected to have no effect on the annual aggregate expenditures for providing ABA services; payment rates are not affected by the new credentials.

SPA 17-0024 is in the development process; therefore a copy is not yet available for review. The agency would appreciate any input or concerns regarding this SPA.
