The Washington state transportation commission (WSTC) sets toll rates for all toll facilities in the state. On January 17, 2018, WSTC amended its policy requiring a sufficient minimum balance (SMB) in the Tacoma Narrows Bridge (TNB) account. (WSTC Policy and Procedure 15).

As amended, SMB shall not be less than ten million dollars instead of 12.5 percent of annual operating expenses. Determination of whether the account is meeting the SMB requirement continues to be measured with a retrospective three-month rolling average fund balance. The amended policy also includes the TNB civil penalty fund balance to calculate SMB, and clarifies the required action by the commission if the account is projected to fall below SMB.

Title or Subject: Medicaid State Plan Amendment (SPA) 18-0015 Substance Use Disorder Rates.

Effective Date: April 1, 2018.

Description: The health care authority (HCA) in conjunction with the behavioral health administration in the department of social and health services (DSHS) intends to submit medicaid SPA 18-0015 in order to change the effective date of fee-for-service (FFS) rates for detoxification services provided in approved alcohol/drug treatment centers.

In 2016, the Washington state legislature passed E3SHB 1713, requiring DSHS to develop detoxification services that are more intensive than those currently available. While this new treatment option falls under an existing state plan service, the state intends to add a new category to the existing substance use disorder rates. Therefore the only change to the medicaid state plan will be to update the effective date for FFS rates paid for detoxification services provided in approved alcohol/drug treatment centers.

\$3,077,000 was budgeted for this new treatment option, to be apportioned among the various entities and methods for delivering the services (e.g., behavioral health organizations, managed care organizations and FFS).
