Title or Subject: Medicaid State Plan Amendment (SPA) 19-0010.

Effective Date: April 1, 2019.

Description: The health care authority (HCA) intends to submit medicaid SPA 19-0010 order to simplify and streamline the dental services section of the medicaid state plan. SPA 19-0010 is not intended to change any of the services currently available to eligible children and adults under HCA's dental program. HCA is taking this opportunity to remove details that are more appropriate for a billing guide, thereby reducing and simplifying the information in the medicaid state plan. In addition, HCA is adding information about the access to baby and child dentistry (ABCD) program. This is not a new program, HCA is adding the information in order to update the state plan to reflect current policy.

SPA 19-0010 will not implement program changes; therefore the SPA is expected to have no effect on the annual aggregate expenditures/payments for eligible providers of covered dental services.
