

WAC 296-45-52510 Current transformer secondaries. The secondary of a current transformer cannot be opened while the transformer is energized. If the primary of the current transformer cannot be deenergized before work is performed on an instrument, a relay, or other section of a current transformer secondary circuit, the circuit must be bridged so that the current transformer secondary will not be opened.
